

HON 386 allows students to satisfy the Honors Experiential Education (EXP) Requirement while doing a full-time internship during the summer without paying tuition. Full-time means at least 30 hours a week for a minimum of 6-7 weeks, or at least 200 hours total. The internship site must provide some mentoring, supervision, or training, and the work must relate to the your educational or career goals. The following checklist will help us determine if your internship qualifies for HON 386. All applications must be received by June 15 in order to be considered. No retroactive applications will be accepted. Submit your application to the DUS, Ryan Voogt, <u>Ryan.Voogt@uky.edu</u>, and cc your Honors Academic Advisor.
