

Honors Experiences

Honors Experiences include the following types of structured learning opportunities: internships/co-ops, practicums, undergraduate research, education abroad, service-learning, and community and field-based learning opportunities. While there are many opportunities that support student learning and success, Honors experiences must be credit-bearing and included on a student's transcript.

Honors considers the following course numbers as meeting the Honors Experience requirement:

- ALL 395 and 495 courses count, from all departments, except those used for Honors Thesis credit.
- ALL 393, 394, 396, 397, 399, 497, 498, and 499 courses count, from all departments, except those used for Honors Thesis credit.
- For EGR 399 and ACC 399, 1 credit will fulfill 6 credits of Honors Experience. EGR 398 fulfills 3 credits of experience.
- ALL student teaching courses. Please contact your Honors advisor for approval of credits within your Honors curriculum audit.
- Education Abroad credits. Please contact your Honors advisor for approval of credits within your Honors curriculum audit.
