Research in Sustainability and the Environment

The Crabtree–Cornell Family Fund for the Environment was established by a generous donation to support the dissemination and creation of knowledge about environmental issues. This fund will support up to three **\$500 awards**. Honors students working **in any discipline** are eligible to apply. Please prepare a proposal (max 3 single-spaced pages), according to this framework:

Project Summary/Abstract

(1 paragraph) that concisely presents the issue related to sustainability and the environment, and the research approach used to address the issue.

Introduction/Context

(1 page) that situates the problem and the student's research approach in context within the existing literature.

Research Methods/Approach

(1 page) that details the student's planned research project. Excellent proposals will demonstrate student understanding of planned methods and document that the student has access to the technical, facilities, and other support necessary to successfully complete the project. Please note that the student must identify a research mentor in this section.

Please **attach a resume**. Recipients are required to present their research to the public. The context and form for the presentation are flexible.
